LIBRARY SERVICES DURING THE RENOVATIONS

Where are the books and journals?

- * Currently, the books and journals are stored in various locations. Our online library [catalog](#) lists the current location of a title, whether it is checked out and who it is checked out to.
- * Reference books (such as maps, writing tools, Landolt-Bornstein) are located in the Librarians' Office in Room 133.

How do I request a book or journal?

- * Email library@stsci.edu or stop by Room 133. During regular business hours, we will retrieve what you need.
- * Our online library [catalog](#) lets you know who has checked out a particular item. You may contact that individual to kindly ask to use the item. If you'd like to transfer the item to your account, let us know by sending an email to library@stsci.edu or drop by Room 133.
- * Our Library's online [catalog](#) usually provides a link to an electronic edition of a book or journal if it is available. Be sure to check the record in our [catalog](#) for this information.

Where are the Library Staff?

- * The Chief Librarian, Assistant Librarian and Library Technician are housed in Room 133.
- * We will staff a mobile library unit on the second floor on a daily basis. Take a moment as you're headed into the building to browse new books and journals, ask a question, request materials or get a demo of new research tools. This service will begin in June.

How can I look at the latest journal issues, magazines, books?

- * We'll keep the current books and journal issues in Room 133. Please feel free to stop by and browse.
- * Our mobile library will also be available on the second floor on a daily basis. (Beginning in June.)

How do I know what is in the Library collection?

- * Our online library [catalog](#) is the definitive source for books and journals in our collection. See our [new books list](#) for the latest.
- * The [E-Journal portal](#) gives a list of electronic journals and magazines to which we subscribe.
- * Use [Article Linker](#) and [LibX](#). These new research tools help to connect you to our library holdings as you search the ADS or look up references.
